WHAT IS THE RESOLVE: NETWORK

- The RESOLVE: Network Partnership was launched in **December 2017** by a small group of NGOs/CSOs across Europe as an initial idea linked to wider Erasmus+ activities.
- The **Youth wing** was launched in **November 2018**, during our first RESOLVE youth exchange in Sarajevo.
- Both the Youth Wing and the Partnership works towards the same core objectives, with the Youth Wing deciding on its own additional youth objectives based on its Youth Board's priorities.

WHAT IS THE RESOLVE: NETWORK

The RESOLVE: Network connects:

- ***Young Leaders***
- ***Reconciliation, Youth & Community Professionals***
- ***Sectorial NGOs***
- ***Strategic Stakeholders (i.e. Decision-makers)***
- ***Academics & others***

The network aims to bring people together dedicated to community reconciliation and committed to transnational reconciliation collaboration: mobilising elements of the RESOLVE Model to achieve the network's ultimate objectives.

- ***Civic Society Organisations***
- ***Youth Organisations***
- ***Social Enterprises***
- ***And other like minded organisations and CSO/Youth workers***

1. Develop young people as the 'Peacebuilders of tomorrow' and promote youth-led social action in communities.
2. Develop new methods of reconciliation to address social intolerance and support the wider sector.

4. Contribute towards theoretical study on reconciliation and wider social development methodologies.
5. Influence policymakers on addressing social intolerance within Europe and beyond!

- International-level
- Country-level

And:

- Complete social action to address social intolerance & community conflict
- Share learning activities & opportunities internationally (as well as volunteering opportunities)
- Platform for social action ideas & success stories
- Offer peer to peer guidance on social action
- Advise the strategic wing, what are youth wing's members wishes

RESOLVE: NETWORK — HOW IT WORKS

RESOLVE: Network meetings/activities:

- **Mobilities activities** (youth exchanges, dialogue activities and other training)
- **Digital meetings**
- **Local meetings** – local network members carrying out local social action

From 2020, the RESOLVE: Network launched its first Youth Conference, which will be organised annually including wider learning events connected for the networks.

RESOLVE: NETWORK – YOUTH BOARD

- The RESOLVE: Network – Youth Wing Board, can have up to 11 Board members, plus Country Representatives (who hold no voting rights).
- The Youth Board lead and manages the Youth Wing of the RESOLVE: Network with the support of the Partnership.
- A RESOLVE: Network – Youth Wing Board member, can be from any country, where there is an active delivery or Partnership member.
- Local Representatives, can be from any country.
- RESOLVE: Network – Youth Wing Board members can be up to 30 years old.

RESOLVE: NETWORK — COUNTRY REPRESENTATIVES

Asfar aims to recruit a Network Representative for each Country to support the development of the RESOLVE: Network in their communities.

Country Representatives will benefit from:

- Opportunities to attend Network meetings in different countries
- Influence the network's future both internationally and on a local level
- Develop their personal and professional experience & skills
- Youth Board — non-voting member
