

RESOLVE: Network

2018 to 2023

The **RESOLVE:** Network, was created by Asfar in partnership with over 25 Civil Society Organisation from 20 different countries, to deliver a series of 'RESOLVE' peacebuilding programmes to address social intolerance and xenophobia in the UK, EU, the Balkans, the Caucasus, the Middle East and North Africa. The majority of the 'RESOLVE' projects and activities, were funded by Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps through the UK National Agency or by Asfar directly between 2018 and 2023.



Asfar coordinated 17 'RESOLVE' peace education projects between 2018 and 2023, offering over 2,000 learning and volunteering opportunities for young people from 21 countries, mobilising the following methodologies:

- Interfaith dialogue
- Sport for Peace
- Theatre & Creative methods
- Democracy & Citizenship
- Social Action & Volunteering





Youth Exchanges



Over 1,000 young people participated in over 30 youth exchange transnational activities, lasting a week or more. Young people developed:

- Peacebuilding skills
- Leadership & Team working skills
- Inter-cultural and Dialogue skil
- Social Entrepreneurship Skills
- Life skills.



Youth Democracy

Over 800 participants engaged in youth democracy and dialogue activities through 3 democracy projects and youth-led peacebuilding conferences organised in the UK, Cyprus, Hungary, Bosnia and Herzegovina, as well as digitally from December 2020.

The next RESOLVE: Network conference is due to take place in Sarajevo, September 2024.





Volunteering & Social

Over 100 UK young people participated in our international Volunteering and Social Action projects in 5 countries affected by conflict.

In addition, 520 young people from from the UK and our partner countries completed their own social action activities through the Erasmus+ 'RESOLVE' projects' mentoring scheme.

Partnership

Through the 'RESOLVE' projects, the **RESOLVE**: **Network** was launched incorporating an NGO and Youth wing, ensuring youth leadership.
